Please find your September AHVRA update below;

WOHVR (Written Off Heavy Vehicle Register)

Good progress is being made with Transport NSW and the ERG (Expert Reference Group). Three meetings have been held with positive results. The Committee members have met with Delta –V Accident Research to assist with the criteria. The criteria has now been circulated to all ERG members for comment prior to approval.

A meeting is scheduled with Transport for NSW representative on Thursday 21 September 2017 with members of the AHVRA committee to be held at MTANSW offices.

Further meetings are scheduled for 8 and 13 October. The Ministers Office has advised they still expect legislation to be presented by the end of the year.

457 Visas

The panel beating trade has been re-instated to the National Skills Shortage List, while Spray painters have not. This is being discussed with Government.

Auto Insurance

Questionnaires have been sent out by Jardine Lloyd Thompson and a good response has been received. If you have not yet responded we suggest you take advantage of this free comparison opportunity.

Financial Ombudsmen Decision

A recent case of dispute between a Consumer and Insurer in relation to damage consistent with an incident has been finalised in the consumer and repairers favour. This involved a commercial vehicle where the damage was disputed by the insurance assessor and the repairers quote adjusted accordingly. The consumer through their Insurance Broker arranged for an independent assessment to be conducted which was in total contrast to the insurers Assessors. The dispute was then referred to the Financial Ombudsmen Service with a finding in favour of the independent assessment resulting in the insurer paying the original repair quotation amount. We remind all repairers that if any issues arise you should contact your Association who will endeavour to provide assistance in these situations.
